In March 2005, Tropicana established a backhaul services group to begin utilizing the boxcars returning to Florida. This group offers rail transportation and transload services.

If you have products shipping to Florida from the Northeast, the Midwest, or California you should explore using the Tropicana Train.



Program Details:


- Direct service to Bradenton, Florida.




Keys To Success: Double Stacking

Railcar Dimensions: 64' x 9'3" W x 10'6" H

12' Doorway with no shelving

Double stacking allows for 66 standard pallets to fit on railcar. Critical to maximize payload.

Standard 76' 8" refrigerated railcars
(capable of refrigerated, frozen or dry loads)

Dimensions:

64' Interior length
9' 3" Interior Width
10' 6" Interior Height
6,216 Cubic Feet

Load Limits:

186,500 lbs.

Load Requirements:

- Palletized, secure shipping pallets
- Floor layer less than 58" to utilize Tropicana's racking system
- Items reviewed for approval for shipment in food grade cars

Keys To Success:

- Freight origin and destinations are close by Tropicana terminals
- Able to ship two to three truckloads per box car.
- Order/Shipping flexibility
